SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Planning and implementation of the Drama program for all age groups during cabin hours, and elective periods.
2. Consult with interested Camp staff on the programming implementation and scheduling of Drama programs.
2. Orientation and education of Staff and Campers to Art areas equipment, procedures, rules and availability.
3. Produce with volunteers, a play production for the elective special interest group
4. Communication with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems, with regards to your area and observance of those needs.
5. Preparation and maintenance of the stage/amphitheater - Physically and programmatically. Make sure it is kept clean, and that all supplies are accounted for.
6. Maintain record of camper's progress.
7. The requisitioning of needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintenance and inventory of all equipment and supplies.
8. When done implementing art programming and maintaining area, should be with assigned cabin.
9. Evaluate in writing, the Drama Program, Camp Program, Staff, and Procedures.
10. Abide by and enforce all camp policies.
11. Walk shmira (OD), supervise cabins at night as assigned.
