SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Develop, plan and implement outdoor education activities (Cabin activities and electives) for campers and Ozrim during cabin hours and elective periods.
2. Assists each unit with the preparation of supplies, packing, the implementation of overnight trips (Will be going with most units on their overnight trips).
3. Keeps overnight supplies organized, clean, and inventoried.
4. Orient and educate Staff and Campers to the Outdoor Education area, equipment, procedures, and rules.
5. Communicate with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems, with regards to your area.
6. Prepare and maintain area - Physically and programmatically.
7. Maintain record of camper's progress.
8. Requisition needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintain inventory of all equipment and supplies.
9. When done implementing Outdoor Education programming should be with assigned cabin.
10. Abide by and enforce all camp policies.
11. Evaluate in writing, the Outdoor Education program, Camp program, Staff, and Procedures.
12. Sit Shmira (OD) as assigned, supervising your cabin at night.
