

## **Housing Information**

What we call cabins are rooms within buildings. Each building has 2-4 cabins. Groups should use cabins by area, not expanding into other cabins until one area is completely used. Discuss needs with Operations manager if your group desires added separation between groups.

Total Camp Capacity is 285

**Area 1** – Houses 60 people

**Grouskay & Strauss Buildings** – Dormitory-style with 2 cabins in each building. Each room sleeps 15 with 6 bunk beds and 3 single beds. These cabins use a central bath house.

**Area 2** – Houses 60 people

**Lewkowitz Building** - 2 cabins with 6 bunk beds and 3 single beds. This cabin has 2 half baths and one full bath in the building. The bathrooms are locked unless requested to be open.

**Frazin Building** – 2 cabins with 15 beds (central bath house)

**Area 3** – Houses 60 people

**Sisterhood Building** - 4 cabins sleep 15, with 6 bunk beds and 3 singles in each (central bath house)

**Area 4** – Houses 60 people

**Upper Quad** – 4 cabins sleep 15, with 6 bunk beds and 3 singles in each (central bath house)

### ***Adult/Family Housing***

**Upstairs Recreation Center/Barn:** 6 semi-private rooms with 2 full size beds in each room Every 2 rooms share bathroom and shower facilities.

**Infirmary:** One room with a Queen-sized bed and private bathroom. Two semi-private patient rooms with three single beds in each and 1 isolation room with one bed and one sink, all share central bathroom facilities in the infirmary building;

**Infirmary Annex (Doctor's Suite):** Part of the infirmary building with door that leads to the main room of the infirmary, from a hallway leading to the annex rooms. Two rooms each with a Queen-sized bed and access to a shared private bathroom. The front room has an outside door. The back room is only accessed through the hall from the infirmary or front room.

**Lerner:** 2 individual rooms, one Queen bed in each with private baths.
