SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Planning and implementing a horseback riding program for all age groups to during cabin hours, and elective periods.
2. Orient and educate staff and campers about the horse equipment, area, procedures, and rules.
3. Communicate with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems with regards to your area and observance of those needs.
4. Preparation and maintenance of the horse area. Keep in constant communication with the wranglers about the horses, rides, and maintenance.
5. Be the liaison between camp and the wranglers. Inform them of how many rides are going out each day, and how many campers on each ride.
6. Maintain record of campers progress.
7. Requisition needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintenance and inventory of all equipment and supplies.
8. When done with horseback riding responsibilities, should be with assigned cabin.
9. Evaluate in writing, the horse program, Camp Program, Staff, and Procedures
10. Abide by and enforce all camp policies
11. Sit Shmira (OD), supervise cabins at night as assigned.
