



JOB DESCRIPTION – LIFEGUARD SPECIALIST

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Entering College Freshman or 18 years of age
2. Experience significant for camping
3. Previous experience in water safety and Swimming Instruction, comparable to conditions present at Camp Stein.
4. Possess Red Cross Lifeguard Certification or equivalent.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Develop a recreational swimming program that stresses safety and fun for campers and CITs to include cabin hours and elective periods.
2. Develop swimming instruction for all age groups - time to be split between instructional and free swimming. Plan and implement lesson plans during instructional time.
3. Orientation and education of staff to the pool area, use of equipment, procedures, and rules.
4. Communication with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems, with regards to your area and observance of those needs.
5. Preparation and maintenance of area - Physically and programmatically. Clean pool daily.
6. Orientation of campers on rules of pool area including: Swimming, Diving, Out of Pool area, free swim, games, use of equipment, waterslide, warning signals, and other procedures.
7. Involvement in programs including: planning, facilitating, set-up, lean-up and preparation of materials that use the pool area.
8. The requisitioning of needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintenance and inventory of all equipment and supplies.
9. Support and relieve Canoeing Staff when able and needed.
10. When done implementing pool programming and maintenance, should be with assigned cabin.
11. Evaluate in writing, the Aquatics Program, Staff, and procedures making suggestions for the future.
12. Abide by and enforce all camp policies.

13. Sit Shmira (OD) as assigned, supervising cabins at night.
