SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Plan and implement Rocks/Ropes Course programs for all age groups during cabin hours and elective periods.
2. Attend Rocks/Ropes Course training program.
3. Orient and educate of Staff and campers to Rocks/Ropes area equipment, procedures, rules and availability.
4. Communicate with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems, with regards to your specialty area and observance of those needs.
5. Prepare and maintain Rocks/Ropes Course area - Physically and programmatically.
6. Maintain record of camper's progress in specialty area.
7. Requisition needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintain and take inventory of all equipment and supplies.
