- *Help develop ideas and content for Facebook/Instagram posts, Blog and website for parents and family members to see.*
- *Write, print, and distribute the "Stein Times" each day, except for on Shabbat.*
- *Develop and present an end of the session slide show at the end of each 2 week session and the end of the month long sessions.*
- *Create a slide show/video for the camp reunion after camp in December*
- *Requisition needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintenance and inventory*

- *When done with media responsibilities, should be with assigned cabin.*

- *Sit Shmira (OD), supervise cabins at night as assigned.*

Position Requirements:

- Entering College Freshman or 18 years of age
- Experience significant for camping
- Previous experience in specialty area, comparable to conditions present at Camp Stein.
- The ability to live in a cabin, oversee campers and work with co-counselors.
- The ability to handle stressful situations.
- Ability to have open communication with director supervisors about issues that may arise with campers and/or photo/video program
